

- For Alfresco process services only





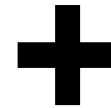
